On a typical day in Monmouth County, 242 children are homeless. If you did not know this, you are in the majority.

Cardboard Box City is a grassroots community event designed to publicize the growing incidence of family homelessness and to raise money for Family Promise of Monmouth County, which works directly with families experiencing temporary homelessness.

FPMC has an astonishing 80 percent success rate. It relies on a network of more than a thousand local volunteers from all faiths and backgrounds who work together to help families in their communities.

What happens at Cardboard Box City? Music from live bands, inspiring speeches, prizes and games, and best of all, a shared sense of purpose. To connect with the experience of homelessness, Box City 'residents' sleep overnight in a box and dine from a soup line. This is an ideal event to attend with your student group, corporate team or family. Participants bring in donations to secure a spot for their boxes. Please plan to join us.

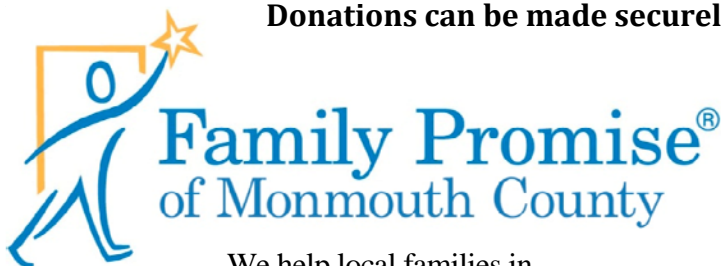
